

Community Service Program

Thousands of hours a year are volunteered to public, nonprofit causes by people who have run-ins with the law. This can be a valuable tool for you and the kids in your community by volunteering your time and helping us Sendakid2camp. Reachout America has come up with a program that not only helps those that have had a slight mishap with the law, but also allows you to give back to the community while working your court ordered hours at a time that fits into your busy schedule. There are many ways that this program can work for you – here are some examples. One way you can help and we will award you with the hours is to organize your own collection campaign like a community car wash, recycling event or yard sale with the proceeds going to Reachout America/Sendakid2camp. For every dollar earned we will calculate the hours of your service to approximately \$10.00/hr in monies donated or the amount agreed upon by the probation officer (if you have one). Example: you have a car wash that earns you \$200.00 and you donate that money to Reachout America, we will award you with 20 hours of community service work. And the exciting thing is your hard work is now sending a special needs kid2camp.

Another way you can help and we will award you with the hours is to place a collection container in your area restaurants, convenience stores, beauty salons and any other business establishments that there is medium to high traffic. Once you have established the collection containers in these areas it is easy to follow up from there, all you do is go back and collect the monies and turn it in to Reachout America for your credit hours. Of course all placements will have to be verified and you will need to provide us with the following information.

- Name of business where the collection container has been placed
- Address of business
- Owner or Managers name
- Contact phone number of business

Community service is a valuable tool. Juveniles log the majority of community service hours. That's the way it has always been. Many cases are minor enough to give the offender community service. However, community service is rarely used. In some cases a tougher sentence is not required, but still given. This program is designed to help the non violent first time offenders stay on the right track while giving back to the community. Community service hours are also used heavily in Teen Court. That's a volunteer program in which young offenders are sentenced with help from their peers. There's a lot of work that's being done for the community by offenders sentenced to community service hours and people just don't know about it. Many nonprofit foundations can be helped by using the community service hours that first time offenders are ordered to complete. If you have been convicted of a crime for the first time, and have been told by the courts you have to perform community service, then consider this as an option for your community service.

Once you or your probation officer, if you have one, completes this form you will be able to participate in our community service program. This will allow you to work off your court appointed hours while helping kids across America go to camp. When you send us your completed form signed by your probation officer, if you have one, we will then get you started on our program. We will help guide you through our program but it's up to you to organize your car wash, recycling, yard sale or collection campaign. You may also have your own ideas on how to raise funds for the Sendakid2camp program. Either way, it is up to you to raise the donation amount required. Your probation officer, if you have one, will determine the amount of donations you will need to collect based on the amount of time and hours of the community service you need to perform. This is great way for you to help yourself and the community by helping send 1000's of kids to camp across America. Simply download and print letter along with the form and take it to your probation officer, if you have one, you or the officer will then determine

- * If this is an acceptable program for you
- *How much money in donations you will need to collect based on the hours of community service you need to perform
- *How much per hour you will receive.

Once you have completed your collections campaign and have sent your collections to Reachout America, we will then award you our letter of completion of community service. Your community service is now complete, plus you have just helped us Send a Kid 2 Camp. Upon completion of mandated community service hours, we encourage the participant to download and complete our reflections page. We believe that a reflection is the key to learning from any experience in life. Taking time to think about what one has been through helps the individual to assess their values and life goals. Through reflection, the community service experience becomes an integral part of the individuals' life. Like a seed that is planted today and will blossom over time, the community service that is completed today directly and profoundly touches and impacts the life of another, a child in need, over time. Reflecting on that experience helps to ensure that the participant is aware of how their choices influence others in life.
