PLAYGROUND RULES

These rules are in effect at all times, both during and after school hours. We request that all of our parents become familiar with these guidelines to ensure the safety of all who use this playground.

THE CHILDREN ARE NOT PERMITTED TO:

- Play on the hill behind the fenced playground area
 - Climb up the slide
- Slide down the slide any way other than on their bottoms
 - Pick up and/or throw stones
- Carry stones and/or sand up onto the playground equipment
- Swing on the swings in any other way than on their bottoms
 - Climb on the fencing

Further guidelines are as follows:

- The Three-Year-Olds are not allowed outside of the fenced in play area and must stay a safe distance from the parking lot when going to/from the school playground area.
- The Four-Year-Olds and the Kindergartners are allowed outside of the fenced playground area during recess *with* adult supervision. However, when this occurs the lower lot must first be blocked off (by Lambs Staff) in order to divert traffic to the upper lot. (This is in compliance with the State Regulations and for the safety of our students). Whether inside or outside of the fenced area, the children must abide by the above rules and are not allowed to pick up sticks, stones, etc.
- When the hill is covered with snow, the Four-Year-Olds and the Kindergartners are allowed to slide down the larger part of the hill – only if there are two adults to supervise (one at the top and one at the bottom). A child who is unable to follow the rules, and the teacher's instructions, will not be allowed to remain on the hill.
